


### Research funding in Switzerland

- Swiss National Science Foundation (SNSF) is
  Switzerland's main funding agency for basic research
- Annual budget of CHF 1.1 billion
- 5500 projects funded with more than 20'000 researchers by 2022
- SNSF-funded AMR research:

29 on-going CHF 25 mio.


136 completed CHF 54 mio.








### AMR research of strategic importance

#### **SwissStrategy on Antibiotic Resistance (StAR)**

- Purpose: Preventing the emergence of new antibiotic resistances and limiting their transmission and spread together with the international community
- Action plan with 8 fields of activity:





## Thematic research funding: AMR programmes





#### **National Research Programme (NRP)**

- Generate scientific knowledge to address
  Switzerland's most pressing social and economic challenges
- 5 years
- Total budget of CHF 10-20 million
- 5 on-going NRPs
- 76 completed NRPs → NRP 72 AMR

#### **National Centre of Competence for Research (NCCR)**

- Long-term research projects in areas of strategic importance for Switzerland
- Up to 12 years
- Annual budget of CHF 5 17 million
- 14 on-going NCCRs → NCCR AntiResist
- 28 completed NCCRs



### Swiss participation in JPIAMR and OH AMR

- Participation in 17th JPIAMR Call 2024 CHF 600'000 for Swiss-based partners
- Swiss-based participants in previous calls
